The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. All members present with supervisor Grobe arriving at 9:15 A.M. Chairman Belt presiding.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

1. CONSENT AGENDA

After discussion was held by the Board, a Motion was made by Schultz, and seconded by Shea, to approve:

2. SCHEDULED SESSIONS

After discussion was held by the Board, a Motion was made by Schultz, and seconded by Wichman, to allow the Amended Leave Police During COVID-19 Emergency to expire on February 2, 2021 and allowing those employees currently quarantining to remain covered until they return to work. UNANIMOUS VOTE. Motion Carried.

Motion by Schultz, and seconded by Shea, to approve and authorize Board to sign **Resolution No. 10-2021** as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 10-2021

RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE NECESSITY AND SETTING DATES OF A CONSULTATION AND A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSED POTTAWATTAMIE COUNTY COURTHOUSE CAMPUS URBAN RENEWAL PLAN FOR A PROPOSED URBAN RENEWAL AREA IN POTTAWATTAMIE COUNTY, STATE OF IOWA

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that one or more blighted areas, as defined in Chapter 403, Code of Iowa, exist within the County and the rehabilitation, conservation, redevelopment, development, or combination thereof, of the area is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety, or welfare of the residents of the County; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reasonable cause to believe that the area described below satisfies the eligibility criteria for designation as an urban renewal area under Iowa law and has caused there to be prepared a proposed Pottawattamie County Courthouse Campus Urban Renewal Plan ("Plan" or "Urban Renewal Plan") for the Pottawattamie Courthouse Campus Urban Renewal Area ("Area" or "Urban Renewal Area"), which proposed Plan is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Plan is to form the Pottawattamie County Courthouse Campus Urban Renewal Area suitable for blight remediation activities and to include a list of proposed projects to be undertaken within the Urban Renewal

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Area, and a copy of the Plan has been placed on file for public inspection in the office of the County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, the property proposed to be included in the Urban Renewal Area is legally described in the Plan and this Board has reasonable cause to believe that the Area described in the Plan satisfies the eligibility criteria for designation as an urban renewal area under Iowa law and; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Area is within two miles of the corporate boundaries the City of Council Bluffs, Iowa, and accordingly, the County will enter into a joint agreement with the City of Council Bluffs to allow the County to operate within the proposed Area; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the area be redeveloped as part of the overall redevelopment covered by the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa statutes require the Board of Supervisors to submit the proposed Urban Renewal Plan to the Planning and Zoning Commission for review and recommendation as to its conformity with the general plan for development of the County as a whole prior to Board approval of such Plan, and further provides that the Planning and Zoning Commission shall submit its written recommendations thereon to this Board within thirty (30) days of its receipt of such proposed Urban Renewal Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa statutes require the Board of Supervisors to notify all affected taxing entities of the consideration being given to the proposed Urban Renewal Plan and to hold a consultation with such taxing entities with respect thereto, and further provides that the designated representative of each affected taxing entity may attend the consultation and make written recommendations for modifications to the proposed division of revenue included as a part thereof, to which the County shall submit written responses as provided in Section 403.5, Code of Iowa, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa statutes further require the Board of Supervisors to hold a public hearing on the proposed Urban Renewal Plan subsequent to notice thereof by publication in a newspaper having general circulation within the County, which notice shall describe the time, date, place and purpose of the hearing, shall generally identify the urban renewal area covered by the Plan and shall outline the general scope of the urban renewal project under consideration, with a copy of the notice also being mailed to each affected taxing entity.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF POTTAWATTAMIE COUNTY, STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That the consultation on the proposed Urban Renewal Plan required by Section 403.5(2), Code of Iowa, as amended, shall be held on February 9, 2021, in the Board of Supervisors Room, County Courthouse, 227 South 6th Street, Council Bluffs, Iowa, at 12:00 P.M., and Chairperson Scott Belt, or his delegate, is hereby appointed to serve as the designated representative of the County for purposes of conducting the consultation, receiving any recommendations that may be made with respect thereto and responding to the same in accordance with Section 403.5(2), Code of Iowa.

Section 2. That the County Auditor is authorized and directed to cause a notice of such consultation to be sent by regular mail to all affected taxing entities, as defined in Section 403.17(1), Code of Iowa, along with a copy of this Resolution

and the proposed Urban Renewal Plan, the notice to be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF A CONSULTATION TO BE HELD BETWEEN POTTAWATTAMIE, STATE OF IOWA AND ALL AFFECTED TAXING ENTITIES CONCERNING THE PROPOSED POTTAWATTAMIE COUNTY COURTHOUSE CAMPUS URBAN RENEWAL PLAN FOR POTTAWATTAMIE COUNTY, STATE OF IOWA

Pottawattamie County, State of Iowa will hold a consultation with all affected taxing entities, as defined in Section 403.17(1), Code of Iowa, as amended, commencing at 12:00 P.M. on February 9, 2021, in the Board of Supervisors Room, County Courthouse, 227 South 6th Street, Council Bluffs, Iowa concerning a proposed Pottawattamie County Courthouse Campus Urban Renewal Plan for a proposed Pottawattamie County Courthouse Campus Urban Renewal Area, a copy of which is attached hereto.

Each affected taxing entity may appoint a representative to attend the consultation. The consultation may include a discussion of the estimated growth in valuation of taxable property included in the proposed Urban Renewal Area, the fiscal impact of the division of revenue on the affected taxing entities, the estimated impact on the provision of services by each of the affected taxing entities in the proposed Urban Renewal Area, and the duration of any bond issuance included in the Plan. The Plan does not propose the use of tax increment financing in connection with the urban renewal projects identified in the Plan.

The designated representative of any affected taxing entity may make written recommendations for modifications to the proposed division of revenue no later than seven days following the date of the consultation. Chairperson Scott Belt, or his delegate, as the designated representative of the County, shall submit a written response to the affected taxing entity, no later than seven days prior to the public hearing on the proposed Pottawattamie County Courthouse Campus Urban Renewal Plan, addressing any recommendations made by that entity for modification to the proposed division of revenue.

Pottawattamie County, State of Iowa is the local public agency which, if such Plan is approved, shall undertake the urban renewal activities described in such Plan.

The general scope of the urban renewal activities under consideration in the Plan is to rehabilitate, conserve and redevelop land, buildings and other improvements within such area through the elimination and containment of conditions of blight so as to improve the community through the establishment of effective land use controls, through use of an effective program of rehabilitation of existing buildings and elimination of those structures which cannot be economically

rehabilitated, with a limited amount of acquisition, clearance, resale and improvement of land for various purposes specified in the Plan. To accomplish the objectives of the Plan, the Plan provides that the County may use special financing tools and may reimburse or directly undertake the installation, construction and reconstruction of substantial public improvements and public buildings. The Plan provides that the County may issue bonds or use available funds for purposes allowed by the Plan. The Plan does not propose the use of tax increment financing in connection with the urban renewal projects identified in the Plan. The Plan initially proposes specific public infrastructure or site improvements to be undertaken by the County, and provides that the Plan may be amended from time to time.



Re: Bridge Crew Restructure

Why the restructuring?

Our department has struggled with retention on the Bridge Crew. Our bridge crew is currently a team of four Truck Driver/ Laborers and one Crew Leader. These Employees are required to be OSHA Certified Riggers and Crane Operators, which isn't required in other positions and can take several years to attain. When we post a job internally we typically see a Bridge Crew employee bid that position due to better wages and working weather conditions. When we have to replace a Bridge Crew vacancy we are back to square one on training and therefore behind on work efficiency.

Fixing Sustainability

In order to maintain a Bridge Crew internally we need to address the fact that they are required to maintain higher certifications. We are proposing to implement a training and succession plan to minimize the disruption of Employee transfers.

The first step is updating the Bridge Crew job descriptions to reflect the responsibilities and qualifications these employees possess. We recommend Technicians I, II, III to follow the Unions current structure. We would like to eliminate the Truck Driver/Laborer position from the Bridge Crew altogether. The proposed job descriptions and structure, create overlap of skills in a developing capacity and internal succession. The benefit of overlapping skills, is that the crew doesn't suffer if a particular employee leaves or is unavailable. The importance of an experienced crew are: efficiency, safety, and culture – which strongly outweigh the cost increase of about 2%. In order to move our five employees from their current structure and to the proposed structure, we would see a cost increase of approximately \$4,850.00 for four employees, the Crew Leader wages wouldn't change.

General Definition of Work

Performs a range of semiskilled and skilled work demolishing, constructing, maintaining and repairing County Bridges and Culverts using a variety of techniques and materials. The work is performed under the limited supervision of the Bridge Crew Foreman.

Classifications

There are three classifications in this job:

<u>Bridge Technician I:</u> Certified Rigger. The employee performs a range of bridge maintenance, repair, and construction assignments in a learning capacity.

<u>Bridge Technician II:</u> Crane Operator in Training. The employee performs a range of bridge maintenance, repair, and construction assignments in a developing capacity.

<u>Bridge Technician III:</u> Certified Crane Operator. The employee performs full range of bridge maintenance, repair, and construction assignments in a leadership capacity.

Essential Functions

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable an individual with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Proficient in concrete form work, carpentry, concrete finishing, compacting backfill materials, tying rebar, welding, fencing and structural bolting techniques.

Proficient with crew equipment, equipment operations and standardized hand signals to communicate amongst crew members to ensure safe operations. Crew equipment may include but is not limited to, dump trucks, skid loaders, loaders, excavators, dozers, and cranes.

Proficient in survey and plan reading to facilitate the layout, fabrication and construction of a bridge and culvert components.

Observant of field conditions that may jeopardize the safety of the coworkers or public and work to provide a resolution. Examples may include identifying broken plank or structural components, sloughing soils, erosion, deterioration, debris, or other issues that affect the capacity or function of a bridge or culvert.

Provides traffic control in construction and maintenance zones or emergency situations.

Operates, monitors, repairs, and maintains assigned equipment and vehicles; maintains equipment and vehicle service log.

Minimum Qualifications

High school diploma or GED and moderate experience operating medium to heavy equipment and vehicles, performing manual labor.

Valid commercial driver's license with Class A and Air Brake Tanker endorsement in the State of Iowa.

Special Qualifications

All Technicians must obtain Riggers Level 1 Certification within one year of hire.

Bridge Technician I: Entry level, no specific type or amount of experience required.

<u>Bridge Technician II:</u> Minimum 2 years experience in bridge maintenance work or as a semi-skilled worker in bridge or industrial construction, including the operation of specialized equipment and/ or cranes.

<u>Bridge Technician III:</u> Minimum of 4 years experience in bridge maintenance work or as a semi-skilled worker in bridge or industrial construction, including the operation of specialized equipment and/ or cranes. Must obtain and maintain an OSHA approved Crane Operator Certificate.

Job Specifications

Knowledge of the materials, equipment, processes, and tools use in the construction and maintenance of bridges ,general knowledge of the practices and techniques of construction, maintenance, and repair operations; general knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety rules and regulations involved in the work; general knowledge of the safe operation of medium to heavy construction equipment and vehicles; general knowledge of various ordinances, codes and regulations pertaining to construction; general knowledge of specialized tree and snow removal equipment; skill in the use of personal computers, associated software packages, hardware, and peripheral equipment; skill in the use of hand and power tools; skill in the use and operation of assigned equipment and vehicles; ability to perform manual labor; ability to pay close attention to small details; ability to work and coordinate on multiple congruent projects; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, supervisors, vendors, and the general public.

Working Conditions

This work requires the regular exertion of up to 10 pounds of force, frequent exertion of up to 25 pounds of force and occasional exertion of up to 50 pounds of force; work regularly requires reaching with hands and arms, frequently requires standing, walking, sitting, speaking or hearing, using hands to finger, handle or feel, pushing or pulling and lifting and occasionally requires climbing or balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching or crawling, tasting or smelling and repetitive motions; work has standard vision requirements; vocal communication is required for expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word and

conveying detailed or important instructions to others accurately, loudly or quickly; hearing is required to perceive information at normal spoken word levels and to receive detailed information through oral communications and/or to make fine distinctions in sound; work requires preparing and analyzing written or computer data, visual inspection involving small defects and/or small parts, using of measuring devices, assembly or fabrication of parts within arms-length, operating machines, operating motor vehicles or equipment and observing general surroundings and activities; work frequently requires working near moving mechanical parts, exposure to fumes or airborne particles, exposure to toxic or caustic chemicals and exposure to outdoor weather conditions and occasionally requires wet, humid conditions (non-weather), working in high, precarious places, exposure to the risk of electrical shock and exposure to vibration; work is generally in a loud noise location (e.g. grounds maintenance, heavy traffic).
