RESOLUTION TO PROCEED BY EMINENT DOMAIN PURSUANT TO IOWA CODE §6B.2C TO CONDEMN REAL ESTATE IN POTTAWATTAMIE COUNTY, IOWA FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONSTRUCTING ROAD IMPROVEMENTS ON DUMFRIES AVENUE FROM ASPEN ROAD TO PIONEER TRAIL

WHEREAS the County has implemented plans to upgrade and pave Dumfries Avenue from Aspen Road to Pioneer Trail in Pottawattamie County, Iowa; and

WHEREAS there is a reasonable expectation that the County will be able to achieve its public purpose and comply with all applicable standards for the same; and

WHEREAS the laws of the State of Iowa require the passage of a resolution by the County prior to its implementation of eminent domain by condemnation proceeding pursuant to the Iowa Code; and

WHEREAS a Temporary Easement for purposes of roadway improvement and construction, and a Permanent Easement for roadway purposes, is required to achieve the goals of the public improvement project; and

WHEREAS the County has unsuccessfully attempted to negotiate the voluntary sale of property necessary for the completion of the project prior to initiating eminent domain proceedings.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Pottawattamie County, Iowa that the County approves proceeding by eminent domain pursuant to the laws of the State of Iowa to condemn the property owned by Henry C. Brandt, Jr., Linda Brandt, Jane Triptow, Barbara Frederick, and Vic Frederick legally described as:

A portion of Section 24, Township 74 North, Range 43 West in Pottawattamie County, Iowa, more specifically described in the Permanent Easement Plat and Temporary Easement exhibits attached to this Resolution.
