WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pottawattamie County, Iowa (the "Board"), contemplates amendments to the existing Pottawattamie County, Iowa, Zoning Ordinance (the "Ordinance"), to include provisions regulating wind and solar energy conversion systems; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to impose a moratorium prohibiting the Director of Planning and Development and the Zoning Board of Adjustment, from accepting or otherwise acting on any application to develop a wind or solar energy conversion system, including a "wind farm" as the Ordinance currently defines, for 365 days from the effective date of this resolution, or until the Board completes its review and amendment of the Ordinance regulating wind and solar energy conversion systems, whichever is earlier.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board hereby approves this resolution. The moratorium described above shall be effective as of the date below.
